

Sample High School Course Requirements

This sheet is merely an example of what you might include as your own high school graduation course requirements. Please be diligent to comply with any state homeschool requirements that you have. Check with HSLDA for more information on your state homeschool laws. (www.hslda.org) I also suggest looking over college entrance requirements for the different colleges your student is considering attending.

Christian Heritage School

- All students enrolled at Christian Heritage School are required to take Bible classes.
- One credit will be awarded for a typical year-long course consisting of roughly 120 hours of work.
- A half credit will be awarded for completion of a semester course consisting of roughly 60 hours of work.
- A minimum of 24 credits are required for graduation. These credits must include the following plus additional electives:

Subject	# Required Credits	Suggested # Credits
English	3	4
Mathematics	2	3 (4, if going into math field)
Science	2	3 (one with lab)
History/Social Studies	3	4
Foreign Language	1	3
Fine Arts	1	2
Physical Education	2	2
Bible	2	2

The above chart shows the high school course requirements I have established for our (home) school.

- The first column shows the required subjects that must be taken before graduation, excluding electives.
- The second column shows the minimum requirements needed to graduate from our (home) school.
- The third column is the suggested number of credits we think is ideal to have for graduation and the best option for those children considering college.
- Colleges want 2 to 3 years of the same language.
